Ohio Department of Education <i>Licensed</i> School Social Worker	
	Master's Degree in Social Work is required
	Clinical level skillset
	Coursework in school law
	Coursework in special education law, protocols, and procedures
	Can be independently licensed for clinical purposes; not requiring clinical supervision
	Generally, participate in training rendering them qualified to conduct risk assessments for students reporting suicidal and/or homicidal ideation
	Qualified to use the term School Social Worker
	Dually Licensed by the Ohio Department of Education (Pupil Services-School Social
	Worker) and Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage & Family Therapist Board
Ohio Department of Education <u>Registered</u> Social Worker	
	A Master's Degree is not required
	Limited scope of practice
	Registered Social Workers can be granted a license (LSW) through the Ohio Counselor,
	Social Worker, and Marriage & Family Therapist Board with a <i>Bachelor</i> of Social Work
	Degree
	Bachelor's Degree Social Workers are trained to perform the services of a generalist
	social worker, not the specific services performed by a school social worker
	The LSW license designation is an entry-level license, must pass entry level exam only
	Bachelor's degree social workers are not able to obtain clinical license
	LSW level social workers can require clinical supervision from an advanced-licensed
	behavioral health professional
	Registration grants the social worker permission to work in Ohio Schools but not be
	identified as a School Social Worker
	A pupil services license is not required
	The application for the Ohio Department of Education pupil services registration is under the <i>Pupil Services</i> category in the online CORE licensure system.
